## L.A. X Upsets Defending Champs, **Advances to PBA League Elias Cup Finals** Clutch spare by Jason Belmonte, strike by Parker Bohn III eliminates New York City WTT KingPins

ALLEN PARK, MI - A clutch ninth-frame spare by reigning Professional Bowlers Association Player of the Year Jason Belmonte followed by three equally clutch 10th frame strikes in the Baker team finale by Parker Bohn III gave L.A. X a 5-1 victory over the defending PBA League champion New York City WTT KingPins and a berth in the 2014 Elias Cup finals.

The first PBA League semifinal round match at Thunderbowl Lanes aired Sunday on ESPN. The second semifinal match will pit actor/ comedian Kevin Hart's Philadelphia Hitmen, led by captain Bill O'Neill, against the Silver Lake Atom Splitters, owned by "Nerdist" creator Chris Hardwick and led by captain Chris Barnes, on ESPN on Sunday, April 6, at 1 p.m. ET. The Elias Cup finals will air on ESPN on Sunday, April 13, at 2 p.m. ET.

The Baker team game, worth a decisive three points in the PBA League elimination competition, was a three-pin contest when Belmonte left the 3-4-7-10 split in the ninth frame, and converted the difficult spare. The spare forced New York City captain Pete Weber to double in the 10th frame to take the lead, but Weber left a 4 pin on his first ball, giving L.A. X. a chance. Bohn, needing a mark and good



count, struck out for a 218-204 win to send Los Angeles Clippers star Chris Paul's team to the Elias Cup finals.

The win was redemption for the Los Angeles-based team that missed a trip to the 2013 finals by two points. It probably wouldn't have happened if Belmonte hadn't converted the split he left in the ninth frame.

"I wasn't too confident; that was an interesting looking spare," the Australian two-handed player said. "I didn't know whether to hook it or throw my spare ball, but I threw my spare ball straight at it and it paid off.

'We get one shot on each lane in team event and I went through the nose on that lane in practice, so when we came back to that lane, I made a five-board move left and threw it really good," he said of the shot that resulted in the split. "I thought it was a strike off my hand, but then I saw it hook and there were grandma's teeth staring at me."

L.A. X is now ready for whichever opposing team advances to the Elias Cup finals.

"We wanted to improve on our position from last year. Our goal was to play in the finals," Belmonte said. "We accomplished that today. I'm stoked. We gelled as a team. We lifted each other. We made spares when we had to. We struck out when we had to. It wasn't just one guy. We have a great team.'

In the singles game between team captains to start the match, Belmonte claimed the first point for L.A. X with

a 234-208 victory over Weber. The decisive shot was Weber's pocket 7-10 split in the ninth frame.

L.A. X added its second point on a near-perfect performance by Mika Koivuniemi and Bohn in a 299-216 romp in alternate-ball doubles. The perfect game was spoiled when Bohn left a 10 pin on the team's 12th shot.

The KingPins, owned by women's sports icon Billie Jean King and presented by GEICO, averted a sweep with a 249-235 come-from-behind win in the Baker trios game. L.A. X, presented by GoBowling.com, was cruising behind Belmonte, Andres Gomez and PBA Rookie of the Year E.J. Tackett until Tackett failed to convert the 10 pin in the ninth continued on page 11

be another PBA Hall of Famer making his PBA50 debut.

Norm Duke of Clermont, Fla., turned 50 on Tuesday. Duke, who still holds the PBA record as the youngest player ever to win a PBA Tour title, will join the ranks of 50-andolder players 31 years after that memorable event. Duke was 18 years and 345 days old when he defeated Tom Milton of St. Petersburg, Fla., 238-204, to win the 1983 Cleve-

land Open.

Duke, who is tied for third place on the all-time PBA Tour titles list with fellow PBA Hall of Famer Pete Weber - last year's PBA50 Rookie of the Year – is eligible for PBA50 competition in 2014 along with 33-time PBA Tour winner

and hall of famer Parker Bohn III (who turned 50 last July, at the close of the 2013 season), along with PBA Tour titlists Dave Arnold (New Year's Day), twin brothers Mike and Mark Scroggins (March 12) and Rick Steelsmith (June 1). Duke wasn't sure if he

# SUNDAY ON ESPN: Philadelphia Hitmen vs. Silver Lake Atom Splitters in Semifinal Battle for PBA League Elias Cup Finals Berth at 10a.m.

ALLEN PARK, Mich. (March 31, 2014) - Three teams remain in the quest for the 2014 PBA Elias Cup, and that number will be reduced to two after actor/comedian Kevin Hart's Philadelphia Hitmen presented by High 5 Gear meets the Silver Lake Atom Splitters presented by Spiceworks, owned by "Nerdist" creator and television personality Chris Hardwick, in the final PBA League semifinal round Sunday on ESPN at 1 p.m. ET.

Sunday's winner will meet L.A. Clippers star Chris Paul's L.A. X presented by Gobowling.com (Mika Koivuniemi, E.J. Tackett, Andres Gomez, Jason Belmonte, Parker Bohn III) in the Elias Cup championship match on ESPN April 13. L.A. X emerged with a 5-1 victory over the defending PBA League champion New York City WTT KingPins, presented by GEICO owned by tennis legend Billie Jean King, to earn its berth in the Elias Cup Finals.

During each PBA League telecast, teams compete for points in a head-to-head series of single-elimination matches. Each team match includes singles, alternate-ball doubles, Baker trio and Baker team contests. One point is awarded for a win in singles, doubles and trios with three points awarded for a Baker team win. Should there be a tie at the conclusion of the match, a one-ball, sudden-death roll-off will determine the winner.

In Sunday's opening singles match Silver Lake team captain and 17–time Tour winner Chris Barnes will meet four-time Tour titlist and Hitmen team captain Bill O'Neill.

In the alternate doubles match, Barnes will team with 2003 USBC Masters winner Bryon Smith against the Hitmen's twotime Tour winner Ryan Ciminelli and 2011-12 Rookie of the Year Josh Blanchard. In trios, it will be the Atom Splitters' 15-time Tour winner Tommy Jones, three-time winner Dom Barrett and nine-time champion Wes Malott against the Hitmen's Ciminelli, O'Neill and Dan MacLelland.

In the Baker team finale, the Hitmen will send MacLelland, Blanchard, O'Neill, Ciminelli and two-time Tour winner Mike DeVaney against the Atom Splitters' Smith, Barnes, Barrett, Malott and Jones. The winner of the Atom Splitters-Hitmen semifinal will meet L.A. X in the Elias Cup Finals from Brunswick Zone Carolier Lanes in North Brunswick, N.J., April 13 at 2 p.m. ET on ESPN.

ANAHEIM — We returned to Linbrook Saturday and had a light turnout of 166 entries in our one day event. The scores for a strange reason were OVER the top and produced Very High Scores. The cut scores were Men +119, and Ladies at a near record +91. The Super Seniors added to the board (2 men and 1 female) were Ben Bagaoisan +119, Alan "The Dragon" Aguilar, and Jim Moore+109. For the women it was Carla Sanchez +74. Super Seniors are men 63 and over. For the women you just need to be a young 55. That would give us 46 bowlers making it to the semi-finals this week.

For the qualifying squads, our top qualifier for the Men was Michael Duran +282 YES+282 including a perfect game!! Deborah Sanders led the women, and both get a paid entry into a future regular ABTA event. Each week our top seed draws the Match Series, and this time it was worth \$4,400. Mr. "300" Duran drew an Unmatched 131. The Match Series will surely go for \$5,000 (FIVE GRAND) Saturday at CAL BOWL, with the remainder starting the new BACK – UP Reserve Pot!. For the 3-6-9 qualifying we had Sean Johnson, and Joey Rodriguez not able to eliminate one another, so the Pot goes for \$2,900 at CAL. BIG BUCK\$ at CAL My Friends!!

In our optional doubles finishing first were Jo Jo Barcelona and Jarret Handa 1658. Mike Moore and Mark Fisser 2nd at 1636 due to the very high, scores not many entered the doubles. We still paid out 20 places and \$1,250 with low to cash 1525.

In the semis we saw pretty Ada Wong lead the field with a +170 to sit out and bowl for the title this week. Coming in second was Jarrett Handa at +148, to sit out the first round. It took a +77 to make the top 16 Single Elims. Included were 4 Women!!

Top Seed Ada Wong had the honor of drawing the Match Game worth \$935. 131. After a review of all the scores bowled, we had no bowlers who matched that score. We will estimate the new pot at \$2,400 Saturday at CAL BOWL. This week we had six new bowlers join us. Let us welcome these new bowlers, and assure them that we do not usually have such scores anywhere as such.

This would bring us to our Match Play finals In the first round seven losers were eliminated. They received checks of \$100 each. In the round two, the losers were Gerritt Fisser, Ken Morris, John Camisa, and Jarrett Handa and got checks of \$107.50. This would get us down to the final four bowlers. One match saw Vuong Do edge Angela Lung. Hong Kha downed Alan Basto so Angela, and Alan are 4th and 5th and checks of \$115. The semi-final match Mr. Kha vs Mr. Do and the horse winner to be decided. Do paying \$23, and Kha \$77. It would be Vuong to down Crowd Favorite Kha in a 263-213 margin. Hong is 3rd with great bowling and \$200 with Do on the meet the top seed Ada Wong for the title. The investors of horses on Vuong got \$23 for each \$5 entry.

# The Perfect Game

#### Keeping This Article Focused on Coaching: The Magnificent Mancini

Carol: That "Three Stooges" thing you and Dean did last week was a little overboard. How about if we get back to the real reason we write this column?

Steve: I thought we did this to amuse, confuse, and inform your readers.

Carol: This year I'm more interested in the "informing" part. Do you remember the article Frank Weiler wrote about bowlers getting better.

Steve: Of course. We responded by writing a series of articles explaining how to get better.

Carol: Right. Well, because of those articles, I'm getting some emails you need to address.

#### Steve: Great! Let's hear them.

Carol: The first one is from Darlene in Las Vegas. It says, "Steve, I bought your book and did everything you said..... it didn't work for me...... I'm worse than ever....... YOU SUCK!!!!!"

Steve: Yeah, it's not the first time I've heard that.

Carol: Doesn't that bother you?

Steve: Well, sure. Nobody likes to be told, "YOU SUCK!" But she's obviously passionate about wanting to improve, so let me explain what may have gone wrong.

Carol: Good luck!

Steve: Dear Darlene, We are creatures of habit. We get comfortable bowling a certain way and the longer we bowl, the harder change becomes. Every coach knows that changing a student's technique causes their scores to decline at first.

Carol: Then why change anything?

Steve: Because once they become comfortable with superior technique, their scores improve. That takes time. In Darlene's case, it sounds to me like she discarded everything she had been doing naturally and attempted a completely new delivery style. I salute the effort, but "cold turkey" modification is challenging and rarely successful.

Carol: And your advice to her is.....?

Steve: The same as it is for everybody. Be patient and realistic about progressing as a bowler. Go back to what you do naturally and modify your technique gradually. You only have four basic skills to master. Work on improving one at a time.

Carol: That sounds simple enough.

Steve: It is simple! The tough part is getting started and sticking with it. Darlene has to start over again.

Carol: Let's do this so it applies to everyone. How should anyone who wants to improve get started?

Steve: Begin by asking, "Am I the best I care to be?" If the answer is, "No!", the next question becomes, "What are my weaknesses?" We all have them.

Carol: Right! The first step to solving any problem is admitting that you have one. Where should they begin?

Steve: At the beginning, of course. Ask yourself, "Is my stance the best it can be?" I have to tell you, Carol, most delivery problems are caused by defective stances.

Carol: How can a bowler know if their stance is good or not?

Steve: Good question. The stance aims the shot. It has eleven elements which accomplish this goal. One of the most important is holding the ball off to the side, directly over the target-line. Many bowlers don't do this even though it's critical to consistent accuracy. To keep from being overwhelmed, a bowler should work on that element, and only that element.

Carol: Then what?

Steve: They move on to another element, like pointing the forearm at the target. When they can say, "This is the best stance I am able to develop.", they can move on to the push-away.

Carol: Sounds like a long process.

Steve: It can be, but by tackling the challenge in small increments, improvement begins quickly. That's encouraging versus the way Darlene did it, which is discouraging. She can speed the process up by practicing at home in front of a mirror.

Carol: There! That was much better than the "Stooge" thing you wrote last week.

Steve: I suppose so, but I still think a good article should make people laugh once in a while.

Carol: If it'll make you feel better, I'm sure our readers would be rolling in the aisles if they could see you right now.

Steve: Why is that?

Carol: Because there's toilet paper hanging from your shoe!

Steve: What....!!!

Soon, tournament and league requirements gave in and all you need do was show up and pay your fees.

It was a slow death, but a death all the same. Could this be the reason you hear, "Bowling is not a sport."? Have we sacrificed our dignity, our style, our sportsmanship for beer and convenience? "That's what I needed to hear," he continued. "If my sponsors think it's important, it's important to me. My career goal, from the very beginning, was to bowl against the very best in the world and beat them, but when you look at it from the viewpoint of what your sponsors want, it's a whole different landscape."

But Duke said he isn't going to approach the PBA50 Tour as a leisurely hobby.

"I'm going to be prepared. I'm not going to approach this like it's retirement," he said. "It's something I'll take very seriously. I'm not going just to play; I'm going to compete.

"I thought about Pete and Walter Ray and Amleto (Monacelli) guys who were the heroes while we were all bowling on the PBA Tour - I don't remember bowling in events when those guys weren't my competition. So I want to go out there on the PBA50 Tour and equal or exceed what they've already done. It's like starting my quest all over."

Duke said his current plan is to bowl the first three PBA50 Tour events in Florida and North Carolina, plus the PBA Senior U.S. Open and USBC Senior Masters in Las Vegas in June. At that point he'll re-assess his plans for the duration of the PBA50 Tour's 12-event 2014 schedule.
