Paula Vidad has firsts in the CWBA State Scratch All Event Women's Scratch Team events, Women's Doubles event and the Citrus Belt WBA Queens. She also holds three titles in the WWPB Regionals; Mardi Gras Lanes, Westbrook Lanes and the National Bowling Stadium in Reno NV. She also holds the USBC Women's record for most 300 games in a singles tournament (three in twenty eight games- WWPB Palo Alto Ca.) Paula will be a wonderful addition to the Hall of Fame under Superior Performance.

Barbara Metzinger has been involved in bowling for most of her life and has been an asset to the Sacramento WBA, the California Bowling Writers and the California WBA. She's a master of promoting bowling from any angle adding to the success of anything she has chaired. Her tireless drive to GET THE JOB DONE makes her a perfect recipient of the Hall of Fame for Meritorious Service.

Vern Reilly will unfortunately not be in attendance to receive his award, but his spirit lives on in our hearts. He was a quiet, always smiling person who rarely got upset when things or people could have upset him. He was always being sought after by bowlers, bowling proprietors and managers for his knowledge. His work ethic did not go unnoticed. Vern was elected Director of the California State BA in 1976. He was appointed Secretary & Tournament Director for the state in October of 1983. In 1991 when Vern retired, he didn't, instead, he continued to work at the State office during the heavy lead times, and also worked the desk at Alpine Lanes. Vern served as a member of the Transition Committee helping to merge the Sacramento BA, WBA, and YABA. Vern's dedication to the Greater Sacramento area and the State BA certainly earn him the honor of induction posthumously into the Hall of Fame for Meritorious Service.

**Woessner Crushes All-Events Record at Women's Champioships** ARLINGTON Jodi
