## **The Perfect Game**

Steve: Cecil?! Our Cecil? As in, Sing-Sing Cecil? Are you nuts? Carol: No! He's a really great guy; just a little misunderstood. Steve: Misunderstood?! He said he was gonna hunt me down

and kick my.... Carol: Steve, this is Cecil. Cecil, this is the coach.

Cecil: Pleased ta meetcha Mr. Feledge.

Steve: It's pronounced "Feleejee", and ..... what happened to your right hand? Why is it all bandaged up like that? Cecil: Bowling injury.

Steve: But you bowl with your left-hand.

Cecil: Yeah, but I punch the ball with my right hand. Ma taught me that. She always said, "Cecil, jab with yer left, punch with yer right!" So, when I punch my bowlin' ball, I use my right hand. Good advice, huh?

Steve: Why on Earth would you ever want to hit a bowling ball with a closed fist?

Cecil: Well, ya sure ain't gonna teach it nothin' by slappin' it! Any fool knows that!

Steve: That's not what I mean. What does your ball do that makes you want to punish it?

Cecil: It keeps missin' 7-pins, coach! I told ya that in my letter! Steve: Cecil, I want you to listen to me very carefully. I have some advice for you.

Cecil: That's why I'm here!

Steve: Okay, here goes. Cecil, you can drop your bowling ball onto a concrete floor; it will not say, "Ouch." You can hit it with a hammer; it will not complain. You can saw it in half and it will not bleed; set it on fire and it won't even whimper. Punching it with your fist will not teach it how to make a 7-pin spare. Understand?

Cecil: I think so. What yer sayin is, I got a really stupid bowlin' ball. I should just throw it out and get me a smarter one.

Steve: On the contrary, you have a very intelligent and loyal bowling ball. It knows the laws of physics and follows them every time it does exactly what YOU tell it to do.

Cecil: Then what's yer advice?

Steve: Did you even try any of the tips in last week's Bowling News?

Cecil: Sure did!

Steve: And.....what happened?

Cecil: Well, the other day Ma and me and my parole officer went bowlin'. By the way, he's pretty good! Anyway, when I left my first 7-pin I did just what you said. I kept my thumb at 12 o'clock and the ball went into the gutter, so when it came back I gave it a good whuppin! The next frame I left another 7-pin, so I tried moving my stance to the right, just like you said. I almost made it but at the last second that old ball made a right-hand turn just to tick me off! So naturally I had to give it another good whuppin! Steve: Naturally, of course you did...... Uh, Carol, could you

please get me an aspirin? Go on, Cecil.

Cecil: Anyway, my parole officer beats me pretty bad that game. Well, the very first frame of the very next game I leave another one of those sevens! Now, I'm so mad I'm ready to throw Bill at it (he's my parole officer)! But my Ma, she says, "Hey, you missed one to the left and one to the right. Try using both tips and see what happens." That's my Ma, she's real smart. So I move my stance, keep my thumb at 12 o'clock and made that 7-pin sorry it even thought about standing up. I made the next one too, same way! Bill beat me anyway, but I really didn't care cuz I just made two 7-pin spares. Then Bill starts doin' a happy dance.....

Steve: And you got so upset that you lost your concentration and had no idea where your ball was going after that, right?

You can't be more amazed than when you spend some time with today's younger generations.

Whether it is them displaying their flying fingers on computers, their flying feet in gymnastics or their rolling the ball and making parents and grandparents take a good second look at their talent, mentally and physically.

All sports and all fields have their child prodigies. There have been teenagers in every major sport, and many in their early teens, particularly in swimming and tennis.

Many of them have been great or gone on to greatness, at great sacrifice, being forced to grow up too quickly, being forced to choose between fame and fortune early, or after a suitable stretch of education.

In the dream world it would be wonderful if every young athlete in every sport was forced to obtain a high school education at a minimum, and college or other advanced training as a recommended path.

But the real world doesn't work out so neatly.

Some really young baseball, basketball, tennis and hockey phenoms can and do make millions of dollars before they can legally drink or vote. How and when do you tell them they are too young or too unprepared? At 17 they can be accepted into the armed services and put their lives on the line.

So how can you realistically ask any youngster talented way beyond their years to put a hold on opportunities and riches that may not be there later.

In many cases it is boys against men, and girls against women. But boys grow up fast these days and women aren't nearly as mere as they used to be.

Bowlers are amazingly adept at early ages. You can visit any junior program and see obvious talent. But, at 15 many bowlers have been bowling for a decade, and bowl-ing at pro class calibre for years. By the time they are ready for college, many are ready for a shot at the pro tours or the big money tournaments.

Look at the Mark Roths, Johnny Petraglias and Pete Webers and a list of thousands and you could see super stars in the making at ages 17 or younger.

Junior bowlers can't be reminded too often that a 200 game is fine, but an "A" in any subject is better. A tourna-ment win is terrific, but the Honor Roll is more terrific. A 300 game or even a 900 series is great, but a diploma is the greatest.

In bowling there is no reason why both areas cannot be encouraged. A high school or college student can utilize his time so much can be spent on bowling and much can be spent on study. And students can map out a schedule that covers both sides, and gives them the best of both worlds.

Parents, bowling coaches and bowling officials have a duty to counsel young bowlers and not to put too much pressure on them in either way, except to use common sense

Education should always come first, but bowling is an education too, if used wisely, whether you're a shooting star or a struggler. But always hit the books as hard as you hit the pins.
