GARDEN GROVE-Dennis Barrett was having trouble making the board for the semifinals for some time in the ABTA. He finally made it firing a big 268 game. The rest is chronicled in the ABTA History Book as he won from the top seeded position in the top 16 single elims at Valley View Lanes, edging pretty Youna Yun in the final frames. It surely was an exciting title match that went down to the wire Youna Yun had him on the ropes only to lose in a thrilling finish, as Dennis edged the pretty lady in a 151/171-134/160 game. He took a nice \$2,300 top prize home to Placentia.

Dennis bested a nice turnout of 222 entrants which saw cut scores of Men+54 and the Ladies doing a decent +34 to make the semi finals. Super Seniors added to the board were Leo Tartamella, Paul Passarino, and Imee Ahorro. 51 bowlers advanced to the semi finals

The 51 bowlers in the Semis took to the floor, hoping to advance to the finals. We saw ABTA Regular Barrett lead the way in the semis blasting a huge +152, to be the top seed, giving him the benefit of sitting out to bowl in the title game. In second was Fernando Alatorre who was way behind at +74 but he would sit out round one entering in round #2.

After the Semis it took a nice +28 for the men, and -25 (ouch) for the three guaranteed women to make the top 16 finals. The bowlers took to the lanes. The losers in round #1 were Ping Romero, Bohner San Pedro, Tomeika Johnson, Bryan Datuin, Ted Nguyen, David Yun and Steven Hower. They cashed in 10-16th place and \$107.50 each.

In round two we had Alatorre enter. and down the affable Rolly Cueva 203-176. Youna Yun took out Albert Balais 211-199. Mike Morgan out struck Danny Guevarra 231-214. Bo Bonneau bested Katrina Fujikami 217-191. Losers of round #2 got checks of \$120 in 6-9th places

Round three had Youna Yun, on a roll, down Alatorre 217-193, Bonneau edged Morgan in a good one 198-196. Michael and Fernando were 4th and 5th with fine bowling and \$135 each with Youna and Bo to meet for the right to bowl Barrett for the title.

This match had Bo lose his line that he previously had. Youna prevailed in a 217-193 win with Bonneau in third with a great performance and \$215. Youna was

led off, but opened. Dennis struck, then spared and after five frames both had opened twice. Youna led by 9 pins as Barrett was having his troubles. She then marked in frames 6-7. Barrett nightmarishly opened again in the 7th. Things looked bleak for him. Youna had a split in the 8th and Barrett somhow dug deep and miraculously threw a big double in frames 8-9 to close the gap but then opened the 10th again for his 151/171 score. Youna then threw what appeared to be a perfect shot but the 8-10 stood. She then got only 8 out so would now need a spare/strike combo to tie or a double to win the title. She tossed again a great shot leaving a solid 10 pin. She then barely whiffed it and the title (a tough one) went to Barrett in a 171-160 win, the nice \$2,300 prize. Great bowling Dennis, luck seemed finally to be on your side? That clutch double was the key in your win. You came through when you HAD to. Dennis is a great supporter of the ABTA and we are proud to have him as a three time titleist, Great going!
