Gagnon is tops in the "640" with a 251 average while Valenzuela is seventh at 233. While both of these heavy hitting high rollers have been putting up big numbers all season they picked Thursday night to hit it out of the park. Both hit home runs by posting their season highs just lanes apart, "SIDE BY SIDE."

Gagnon's 847 (299 - 248 - 300) just missed topping JUS-TIN BORLAND'S 858 house record. With the season just one-third complete Gagnon has plenty of time to pass Borland. I am betting on him to have at least one more big night and hitting it even further out of the park, breaking the house record.

Valenzuela's 806 (267 -300 - 239) is his first eight hundred series in the league. He is a league rookie but is quickly establishing himself as a league star. A MAJOR LEAGUE star. Chris is a smoothie. A young smooth right hander who has surprised the league veterans. They knew he was good but expected it would take a few years before he would become a star. Surprise, surprise. Chris has arrived.

PBA Tour on ESPN Returns with Landmark PBA Cheetah Championship Dec. 1

Blue oil, woman finalist Clara Guerrero, PBA League Challenge and two PBA Hall of Famers highlight first telecast from PBA World Series of Bowling V

LAS VEGAS – The 2013 Professional Bowlers Association World Series of Bowling from the South Point Hotel in Las Vegas kicks off with another landmark PBA Tour event when the Cheetah Championship airs on ESPN Sunday at 10 a.m.

For the first time in history, viewers will have a visual reference for PBA lane conditioning oil application and the challenges players face, thanks to the introduction of a lane oil with a blue tint for the televised finals. The application of lane conditioning oil has long been a mystery and even an abstract science to many viewers of PBA Tour competition on television. The PBA, in cooperation with its official lane maintenance provider Brunswick, formulated and tested the innovative blue oil that was applied exclusively on the pair

of Brunswick lanes installed in South Point's Exhibition Hall B for the finals. For coverage of PBA's use

of blue oil at WSOB V. The Cheetah Champion-

ship will also mark the third time in PBA history – and the first time in World Series of Bowling history - that a woman has qualified for a PBA Tour telecast. International standout Clara Guerrero of Colombia is the fourth seed and will face eight-time Tour champion Wes Malott of Pflugerville, Texas, in the opening stepladder match. Only Kelly Kulick, the 2010 PBA Tournament of Champions winner, and 2005 Banquet Open runnerup Liz Johnson have previously qualified for PBA Tour TV finals.

The winner of the Malott vs. Guerrero match will have his/her hands full because the finals also include PBA Hall of Famers Pete Weber, the No. 2 qualifier, and top seed Parker Bohn III.

Malott won his eighth Tour title and first major in Bowling's U.S. Open in July when he defeated Jason Belmonte, 214-156, for the title at Western Bowl in Columbus, Ohio.

Weber, who is a contender for 2012-13 PBA Player of the Year honors, captured a historic PBA Tournament of Champions win in April tying Earl Anthony for most major wins with 10. The oldest player to win PBA's signature event at age 50 also recorded his 37th career title, tying Norm Duke for third place on the PBA Tour's all-time titles list. Weber also has seven other top 10 finishes including a third in the U.S. Open during the 2012-13 season.

RESULTS OF DEAF SENIOR BOWLERS OF AMERICA MATCH PLAY ELIMINATIONS

NOTE: This is in response to many who asked why it was not written. So here they are.

LAS VEGAS - In the 17th annual DSBA Men's and Women's Match Play Eliminations held last October 16-17 at The Orleans Hotel and Casino Bowling Center, there were 16 women and 44 men entered in their respective prestigious handicap events. All participated in the Wednesday morning's 4 games qualifying round with the top 8 women and top 32 men handicap totals going in Thursday morning's respective match play eliminations.

Among the 16 women entrants, there were defending champion Mary Sickinger, CA and five former champions trying to win another title. The 44 men included defending champion Dennis Kaufman, CA and three former champions, as well trying to win again.

KATHY SEYMOUR BEAT CELIA SALCEDO FOR 2ND DSBA MATCH PLAY TITLE

In the 4 games qualifying round Patricia Morford, CA with help of her 232 high 3rd game in her 700 series plus her 168 handicap for 868 total led the 8 women for the match play eliminations. Twelve pins back was Violet Greenspon, CA who finished with a 198 for 676 plus 180 handicap for 856. The eventual winner Kathy Seymour, CA placed 3rd with 638 plus 212 for 850. DSBA co-founder Carol Moers, CO placed 4th with 845.

Last year's champion Mary Sickinger, CA with 529 + 232 handicap 761 beat Estelita Murray, CA's 760 by one pin for the 8th place in the match play. Morford's 232 is the only 200 game in this round and also her 700 is the high scratch series.

In the one game match plays, all three Morford, Greenspon and Sickinger lost in the first round. Then Morford in order ousted Greenspon in 2nd round, Sickinger in 3rd round and in 4th round got herself ousted by Moers' tournament high 245 game, which moved Moers into the semi finals.

Meanwhile in the winners bracket, Seymour and 5th Qualifier Celia Salcedo, CA won all their 2 rounds matches and met in 3rd round where Seymour gave Salcedo her first loss. Seymour moved in the title finals and Salcedo got in the semi finals against a hot Moers who was averaging 175+ for her 4 games that day.

In the semi finals Moers cooled off as Salcedo beat her 200-189 with handicap and moved up into the all-California title finals against Seymour. Both Seymour (2010) and Salcedo (2008) were former champions and looking for their 2nd title. Seymour with more handicap beat Salcedo by 5 pins 195 to 190 to claim her 2nd title. The men's results will be in next week.
