Will's series for the day was 798 (198 - 300 - 300). Will said "it was a wonderful day, the good Lord was with me. I was rolling the ball and He was guiding it."

Mister June bowled his perfectos in the Young At Heart League at BRUNSWICK MORENO VALLEY BOWL. Right after that league finished, Will bowled in the West Coast Funtime League. He started his first game in the Funtime League with eight strikes, for 32 strikes in a row.

As far as anyone can remember, Will is the first bowler at Moreno Valley Bowl to roll back-to-back 300s.

AMANDA MILBURN, Moreno Valley Bowl league coordinator, said that "Will has always been a great bowler, and it's been inspirational watching him improve at an age (75) when most bowlers start to decline." In Will June's case it seems like 75 is the new 25! Will June has been bowling off and on for thirty-five years. He currently bowls in four leagues, with a high average of 210. He attributes his success to PRACTICE. Will would like to thank his teammates for their support, and the BOWLING NEWS for recognizing his accomplishments on the lanes.

Half of the Champions field will advance to join a select group of Elite players (multiple PBA Tour champions, hall of famers, current Lumber Liquidators PBA Tour exempt players and more) for the balance of the event.

Ryan Nam Second ABTA Win at Bowling Square & Shoots 300! Beth Borci Hits Match Game of \$3,500 • 3-6-9 is \$2,500 at West Covina Lanes Match Series Estimate of \$1,900 Next Week / Match Game Estimate of \$3,200 ABTA Returns to West Covina Lanes This Weekend For Big Xmas Event Many Gifts Prizes Raffles Drawings This Saturday in Xmas Event

ARCADIA-In our awaited return to Bowling Square, 208 bowlers came out for a very fair, semi tough shot this week., and cut scores were a +80 for the men and +36 for the women.

This week, our three Super Seniors added to the board were Leo Tartamella (+77) and Victor Paolucci (+69) for the men and Bobbie McCollum (+31) for the women. That would give us 49 bowlers making it to the semi-finals this week. Ryan Nam had another career night firing a big 300 game in the semis and went on to win his 2nd title in fine style at his house Bowling Square. More on this in our story here folks. Ryan was white hot at Bowling Square!

For all qualifying squads our top qualifier for the Men was Ely "Camera Man" Cruz with a +191. For the women it was Talia St Angelo with a +115. Each will get paid entries into a future regular ABTA event. Each week our top seed overall draws the Match Series, and this week it was worth \$1,568. The top seed drew a 663 but we had no one that bowled that score. Next week at West Covina Lanes, we will estimate the Match Series at \$1,900. For the 3-6-9 qualifying this week, Matt Garcia was the final person standing to go for the \$2,400 pot. He missed on his first shot and received a \$50 consolation. We will add another \$100 at West Covina Lanes for total of \$2,500.

In the doubles this week, we had 160 groups get into the doubles, with 20 spots paid out. The top prize this week went to Ely Cruz and Marvin Crowder with a 1509 for \$160. In 2nd place, it

was Minh Dang and Je Je Gabriel with a 1449 for \$140. The low to cash was 1384; we paid out \$1600 in doubles.

In the semis this week we saw Ryan Nam bowl a stupendous 300 game in the second game and hold on in the third game to lead the field with a +165 and sit out and bowl for the title. Ely Cruz came in second at +140 and would sit out the first round. It took a +66for the men and women combined to make the top 16. This week, our top seed in

semi-finals had the honor of drawing the match game worth \$3500. The pot maxes out at that amount. We have a second pot growing, and that is currently at \$1965. He drew a 194. After a review of all the scores bowled, we had one lucky person who had bowled that score during qualifying, that was Beth Borci. We are proud of Beth. She and affable Husband Anthony are regular dedicated ABTA Members and can be found with us most every week Great People here Congrats Beth!! With the backup pot, we will estimate the pot to be \$3400 at West Covina for the big Christmas event this weekend .. This week we had 11 new bowlers join us, and four returning member's. Let us welcome these new bowlers to the club, Lorna Navarro, Marilyn Tambio, Jyl Paloma, Brett Yokota, Alex Quon, Mark Kwon, Bert Educalan, Joe Early, Nicholas Early, Jeff Nance, and Andrew Nance.

This would bring us to our Match Play finals now. In the first round the seven losers were Beth Borci, Kerry Lucka, Jeff Taino, Michael Kong, Mark Andrews,

Jaime Perez, and Talia St. Angelo. They would receive checks of \$100 each. In the second round, the losers were Derek Lee, Vuong Do, Pablo Castro, and Cecilia Lung. Each would get checks of \$107.50. This would get us down to the final four bowlers. At this point, our horses would be paying anywhere from a low of \$35 (Jiradej Harnpatanakitpanich) aka BK to a high of \$77 (Darrow Tiongco) depending on who would win. In this round we saw BK (3rd seed) bowling Darrow Tiongco (15th seed). In this match, Jiradej would get the better of Darrow with a 218 to 204 finish. In the other match we saw Michael Benavides (14th seed) bowling Ely Cruz (2nd seed). In this match, Ely would continue his hot bowling and get the bet-ter of Michael in this match with a 288 to 174 final score. Darrow and Michael finished in 4th and 5th getting checks for \$115 each. Our semi-final match was set to be bowled on 11 and 12; we had our 2nd and 3rd seeds into the top 16 bowling each other. In our horses this week we would see Ely paying \$44 and Jiradej paying \$**3**5 if they win their match. In this match Elv would lose his shot as he would open in 6 out of the first seven frames, thus giving Jiradej the victory. The final was 180/223 to 129/175 for Jiradej sending him the title match. For those lucky "investors" that had Jiradej as a horse, he paid \$35. Ely finished 3rd and received \$200.

The title game is set and bowled on lanes 13 and 14 this week. Ryan being the top seed elected to start the match first. Ryan would open in the first frame, but Jiradej also opened as he

missed a 10 pin. Jiradej would get a spare in his second frame. Ryan would come up in the second and third frames and get strikes, with Jiradej getting another spare in his third frame. In the fourth frame for Jiradey he would leave the 2-7 split and only get 1 pin, giving him 53 through 4 frames. In the 4th and 5th frames for Ryan he would get strikes, giving him a 37 pin lead. Jiradej would get spares in the 5th and 6th frames, giving him a 70 through five frames with the mark in the 6th. Ryan would get a strike in the 6th frame and spare the 7th frame, at this point just making it a formality of finishing the match as he had a 147 through six frames. Jiradej would open the in the 7th giving him a 95 through seven, and putting him down by 63 pins. Ryan would finish the match with a 234/269 to 141/184, giving him his second ABTA championship. Ryan would take home \$1000 for the win and an additional \$100 for wearing his ABTA shirt, and \$850 in cash and carry. Jiradej finished

in 2nd for \$500. Champion Ryan Nam is from San Gabriel and used a Storm Reign of Fire drilled by ABTA Champ Jimmy Wong. He is single but "spoken" for by the lovely Christina Chung. He would like to thank Christina for all her support and our "three kids" Bebe, Bubu, and Bailie. Thank you to Michael Kong, Samson Kong, Wilson Che-ung, Adrian, Steven Au, and all the Mao Liu bowlers. Ryan is surely well liked by all. It is great to see him win this one! And after his perfect game in the semis he was truly the star at Bowling Square. What a performance!!
